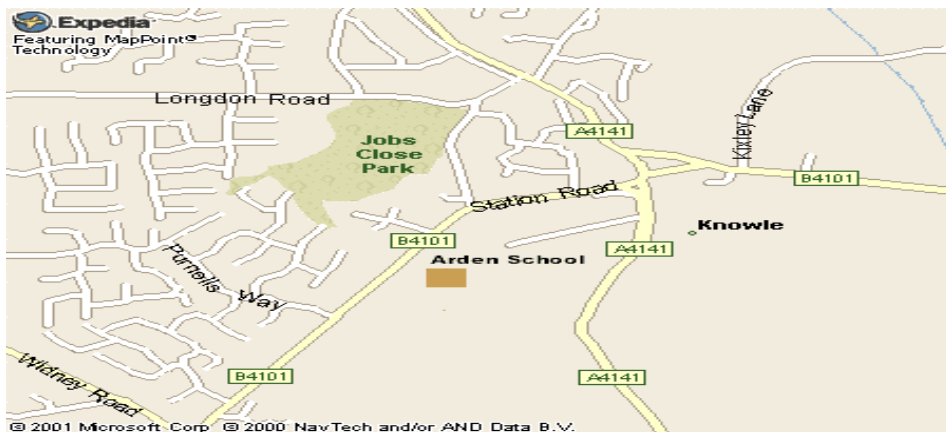

TEAM PRIZE

A Team Prize of £50 for the highest score by a club team of 4 players. Players may compete in any section. Team lists to be handed in by 2.00pm on Saturday.

RATE OF PLAY

36 moves in 90 minutes plus an additional 15 minutes for each player.

ENTRY DATE

All entries received after Tuesday 9th February will be subject to a £2 late entry surcharge. Entries will be accepted on Friday 12th and Saturday 13th at the discretion of the Tournament Director, and then subject to a £5 surcharge.

GRADING

*Ungraded players must supply details of their playing strength on the rear of the entry form. Failure to do so may render the player ineligible for a prize. Ungraded players are not eligible for grading prizes.

GENERAL NOTES

Players will only be eligible for one individual cash prize.

The highest placed eligible player in the Open (not already qualified) will qualify to play in the British Chess Championships in 2010 and will receive a bursary of £50 towards their entry fee.

The highest placed Warwickshire player in the Open section will receive:

- the title of Warwickshire Champion 2010
- The Tucker Trophy for one year

Tie break rules will be on display at the event.

Players not arriving within 30 minutes of the start time of any round will be defaulted and their opponents re-paired if possible.

All disputes will be settled by the Congress Director whose decision shall be final.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to any person without giving a reason.
